Legislative Update

Sacramento, CA

The new 2-year legislative cycle has begun starting December 7th, 2020. Here is a list of Peace Officer Bills that were introduced.

[AB 17](#) (Cooper) - Currently an intent bill to cover the disqualification of certain persons from holding or being employed as a peace officer.

[AB 26](#) (Holden) - This is a reintroduction of his AB 1022 from last year, requiring LEA policies to require officers to immediately report potential excessive force and disqualify a person from being a peace officer if they've used excessive force or have failed to intercede.

[AB 48](#) (Gonzalez) - This is a reintroduction of her AB 66 from last year to ban the use of kinetic projectiles or chemical agents during protests.

[AB 60](#) (Salas) - Creates a POST certification for peace officers, and creates a Peace Officer Standards Accountability Board, makes all records related to the revocation of a peace officer's certification public, requires agencies to report to POST the termination or separation of employment of a peace officer with any compliant, charge, allegation, or investigation into serious misconduct, and disqualifies a person from being a peace officer if they've been convicted or



[AB 89](#) (Jones-Sawyer) - Increases the minimum qualifying age for peace officers from 18 to 25 and permits those under 25 if they've obtained a bachelor's or advanced degree from an accredited college or university.

[ACA 2](#) (Levine) - Would prohibit the death penalty from being imposed as a punishment.

[SB 2](#) (Bradford) - Currently an intent bill to amend the Tom Bane Civil Rights Act and to provide a decertification process for peace officers.

[SB 16](#) (Skinner) - Reintroduction of her SB 776 from last year regarding release of records.

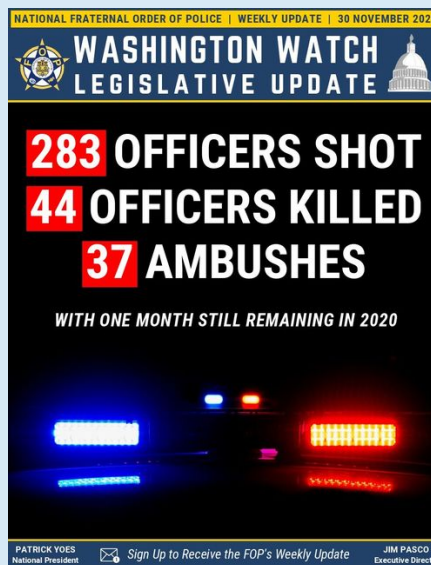
