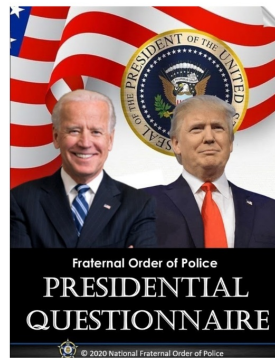

## BILL SPOTLIGHT

[AB 1775 \(Jones-Sawyer\) False Reports and Harassment](#)

- Imposes a fine or misdemeanor on a person who knowingly uses the 911 emergency system for the purpose of harassing another.
- Enhances penalties for knowingly false 911 emergency system calls targeted at a member of a protected class.
- Excludes knowingly false reports to law enforcement from automatically being considered privileged communications.
- Establishes that making or threatening to make knowingly false reports to law enforcement with reckless disregard to truth or falsity, constitutes an intimidation by threat of violence under the Ralph Civil Rights Act.

## Rep. Banks Introduces Qualified Immunity Act

Rep. Jim Banks (IN-03) introduced the Qualified Immunity Act today that would codify clearly established Supreme Court precedent in favor of qualified immunity and the protections it provides for law enforcement agents into statutory law.

“Police officers need protection in order to perform discretionary functions fundamental to law enforcement,” said FOP National President Patrick Yoes. “Every single factual scenario an officer encounters is different and unknown. A reasonable officer needs to be afforded a certain degree of discretion to make split-second decisions in situations that could put lives, including their own, at risk.”
